Set in the historic Yazoo & Mississippi Valley Railroad Co. Depot, now home to LASM, this exhibit reveals the captivating story of the train depot itself.

Explore how the railway expanded Baton Rouge's economy, connecting more than just goods, but also people across vast distances. Marvel at historical railway maps, building blueprints, model train cars, and train memorabilia from the museum's permanent collection. Immerse yourself in large-scale reproductions of historical maps and images, showcasing the stark contrasts between life in 1925 and 2025, from how meals were served, goods were transported, to how personal messages were relayed.

It's a fascinating glimpse into a bygone era, highlighting the lasting impact of the railway on our community.


